	Answer	Buckeye Trivia Tidbit
1.	5	These five coaches defeated Michigan on their first attempt: Jim Tressel (2001) Earle Bruce (1979) , Carrol C. Widdoes (1944), Francis Schmidt (1934), and Sam S. Willaman (1929).
2.	7-1	This is the first time in Ohio State history that the Buckeyes have won 5 times in a row.
3.	OSU won 42 to 7.	Ohio State won the game 42-7. This was the 105 th meeting of these two teams.
4.	50	Ohio State scored 50 points against Michigan twice. In 1961, OSU won 50-20 and in 1968, the Buckeyes won 50-14.
5.	11	In 1900, 1921, 1929, 1931, 1934-37, 1955, 1960 and 1962, OSU shutout the Wolverines. In 1900 the game was a tie (0-0).
6.	5	The Buckeyes played in January in Arizona in 2003 (Miami), 2004 (Kansas State), 2006 (Notre Dame), 2007 (Florida) and 2008 (Texas).
7.	2006 was the first time	OSU & Michigan have played when both teams were undefeated, but they were never ranked #1 and #2 when they met until 2006
8.	Will Allen	The Buckeyes won the game 14-9 to go to the National Championship game against the Miami Hurricanes in the Fiesta Bowl.
9.	3 times	This happened in 1993, 1995 and 1996.
10.	Les Horvath	Ohio State won the game 18-14. Les Horvath played both quarterback and halfback on offense and played safety on defense. In 1944, he led the Big Ten in rushing (669 yards), was the Big Ten's MVP, and became OSU's first Heisman recipient.
11.	Ticket taker	Due to the weather, the ticket taker was not present. So 50,000 people walked in with or without a ticket and watched the 1950 Snow Bowl game.
12.	WRFD studio	In 1951, Jimmy Crum called the game as if he was there by watching a black & white TV in the WRFD studio.
13.	0	In 1955, Hopalong Cassidy was the third Buckeye to win the Heisman trophy (Les Horvath 1944, Vic Janowicz 1950)
14.	Bo Schembechler	Schembechler was an assistant coach for OSU from 1959-63. Schembechler became the Wolverine's head coach in 1969.
15.	Vodka	The copy machine worked well the rest of the game.
16.	Bob Ferguson's chin strap	Ferguson scored 4 TDs in 1961's game & Otis scored 4 in 1968's game. The chin strap crossed Michigan's goal line 8 times.
17.	Prepared for next year	After the bitter 24-12 loss to Michigan in 1969, Woody went to his office and prepared for next year's game against Michigan.
18.	Rug with previous season's score	All of the players were reminded daily of the 1969's loss to the Wolverines that cost them what would have been their second straight national championship.
19.	1972	In his first game against Michigan, Archie scored on a 30 yard run. It was the only TD Archie scored against Michigan.
20.	1973 and 1974	Both times the athletic directors selected Ohio State to go to the Rose Bowl.
21.	Full scholarship	The Buckeyes beat the Wolverines in 1974, 12-10. Klaban kicked four field goals to win the game.
22.	Wore "Earle" headbands	In Earle Bruce's last regular season game as the Buckeye head coach, Ohio State won the game 23-20.
23.	Kirk Herbstreit	To date, Jim and Kirk Herbstreit are the only father-son duo to each have been Ohio State captains.
24.	1990	Woody Hayes was the Buckeye head coach from 1951-78. Bo Schembechler was the Wolverine head coach from 1969-89.
25.	Miami (Ohio)	Woody Hayes was the head coach from 1949-1950 and Schembechler graduated from Miami (Ohio) in 1951.
26.	13	In the 1970's, either OSU or Michigan represented the Big Ten in the Rose Bowl.
27.	1960's & 2000's	In the 1960's, Ohio State (under Woody Hayes) had 7 wins against Michigan and only 3 losses. In the 2000's, OSU has 7 wins and 2 losses. If Tressel's Buckeyes win in 2009, they will break this long-standing record.
28.	1954	In Woody's first Rose Bowl appearance as head coach, OSU beat USC by a score of 20-7 and became National Champions.
29.	3	Buckeyes who were the #1 overall pick in the NFL draft were Tom Cousineau (LB, 1979, Baltimore Colts), Dan Wilkinson (DL, 1994, Cincinnati Bengals), and Orlando Pace (OT, 1997, St. Louis Rams).
30.	1941	FDR was President of the US the last time a Michigan player was selected as the number one overall pick in the NFL draft.
